

Want to Learn to Sail?



Have you ever had the desire to muck about in boats?

Or have you always wanted to learn to sail but thought you had to live by a lake or the sea?

The Thames Sailing Club offers you the chance to learn to sail right here in SW

London in the beautiful, natural and safe surroundings of the Thames River.

We offer beginner and intermediate training courses to adults and children above ten years old. You will learn to sail in the club's fleet of one person and two person boats retained exclusively for training purposes.

Once trained and, as a paid up member of the TSC, you are welcome to join us sailing every Sunday morning and Tuesday evening throughout the Spring, Summer and Autumn. For a small fee per session you have the ongoing use of the training boats for as long as you need.

There really is nothing to beat sailing on the Thames on a summer evening followed by a drink and supper in the clubhouse whilst the sun sets over the bank opposite!

The Thames Sailing Club is a Royal Yachting Association (RYA) accredited training venue. This accreditation is important. The RYA is the governing body for everything to do with sailing in the UK and the RYA training levels are internationally recognized.

On our 5 day course you will be trained to RYA levels 1 and 2 which, providing you pass, certifies you as 'Competent crew'. This level of certification is generally recognized by boat hire companies as sufficient to allow you to hire equipment anywhere in the UK and many places abroad.
